Driven to centerfield
Skied to right field
Lofted to left field

Lined to left field

Looped to right
Hammered to left
Sliced to right
Slugged deep to left
Cue shot

Ground Ball

Grounded to short
Rolled to third
Chopped to second
One-hopper to short
Two-hopper to second
A dribbler to third
Slow roller to first
Push bunt to third
Short hop
Comebacker to the pitcher
A bleeder to third
A nubber to the pitcher
Seeing eyed-single

Line Drive

Scorched to left
Drilled to short
A laser to third
Laced to second
Sharply hit
Slashed to left
Roped to center
Gapper
Gap shot
